METHODOLOGY

Each week ORB International polls a **nationally representative** sample of n=2,000 adults aged 18+ throughout England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland. The core tracking questions are :-

Q. When thinking about the Coronavirus here in the UK which of the following do you think is most likely to happen over the next month?

- 1 The worse is yet to come
- 2 The situation will remain largely the same as it is now
- 3 We are over the worst of it things will begin to improve

How strongly do you agree or disagree with the following statements?

- 1 I think the UK Government is handling the Coronavirus crisis well
- 2 I believe the threat from the Coronavirus is exaggerated

Topical questions each week are inserted and not necessarily tracked week on week.





The statistical margin of error at the 95% confidence level is ±2.2%




CORONAVIRUS: HOW THE PUBLIC SEE THE NEXT MONTH






CORONAVIRUS: PPE AND TESTING



TESTING AND PPE DELIVERY "GOVT DOING ALL THEY CAN"



- The nation is split specifically on the topic of testing and PPE delivery. 48% agree that the Government is doing all they can to increase testing and deliver PPE – while 42% disagree.
- Disagreement is higher the younger people are; disagreement is also higher in Scotland (50%) and Northern Ireland (53%). There is no significant difference of opinion by those working in the private/public sector.






CORONAVIRUS: WOULD LABOUR DONE BETTER JOB?



Labour would have done better job




- One in five (20%) feel Labour would have done a better job dealing with the pandemic – 50% argue they would have not. It is 18-24 year olds who mainly share this view (47%) and those in London (32%) and the North West (31%).
- Interestingly those who work in the public sector share similar views – 26% feeling Labour would have done a better job but 42% disagreeing with the statement.



CORONAVIRUS: UNDER CONTROL?



I think the spread of the virus in the UK Is now under control



- Last week less than one in five (17%) of the UK population feel that the spread of the coronavirus is under control. This week this figures is slightly up at 20%
- Younger people are increasingly believing it to be under control, something which should be a worry given social distancing rules






CORONAVIRUS: SUPPORT FOR A PROTEST



Support a protest against impact of COVID



- One in ten people across the country are bold enough to tell us that they would support a protest against social distancing rules and the economic hardship associated with them.
- Those under the age of 35 are significantly more likely to support it (15%).




Government guidance on social distancing is clear and easy to understand

Agree Concerned about catching Coronavirus (%)




